## Final Paper:

- Your paper should include an introduction, several body paragraphs, and a conclusion. Each body paragraph should have a clear topic sentence, evidence, and analysis
- Your evidence should draw from the course readings, discussions, and lectures (especially Vargas' "Latinos and the Challenges of the Twenty-First Century")

Prompt: Five decades after the Chicano Movement, ethnic Mexicans continue to fight for equal access to education, improved economic opportunities, immigrant rights, political inclusion, and affordable healthcare.
