I'm going to give you some notes, but these are just suggestions and the most important changes should come from your usability testing.

One thing I would like to see in a final draft (and you may be planning this already) is a very short, clear explanation at the beginning about what we'll be doing and why. Just a short intro paragraph is enough, nothing that will get in the way of getting to the instructions quickly.

Also, you might try putting a thin border around the screenshots. The white background and the white page make it a little difficult to see where the screenshots start and the instruction text ends.

And finally, for the text in the red and blue boxes, try setting those words in white. They'll stand out a lot more. Obviously, black text is fine for yellow.
